SCDA Club Risk Assessment Discussion

The hall has not been adapted to meet the demands of Covid. Windows will not open and St. Council will not respond re PVC. **Sheila** will find out what happens at Oran Mor (Glasgow). FADS needs to decide on mask wearing, how to run a bar, seating nos., lateral flow tests etc. for Christmas. Cast would come in costume. We need to hear the voices of members who should be prepared to form a Covid Committee. **Sheila** to get info. from Maggie re St. Council's rules for the hall (Maggie is contacting the Council).

- 4 Kevin spoke to Gavin and Andy earlier re the "Gogglebox" idea. Gavin has a short panto version (6 cast) which could be included. Kevin has asked David to consider Directing. David spoke to me this morning to say that he will not take responsibility but will help with one or two items and Jackie will do the same.
- Gavin and Andy joined the meeting. There is difficulty with ventilation in the hall and we need to follow the guidance of SCDA and keep people interacting. **Tony** suggested Carol (SCDA) could run a Zoom meeting on Covid care and he will contact her. We may possibly rehearse in the hall, depending upon numbers. The consultation to members was divided equally between panto and short scripts but we must abide by guidelines. It was felt that we aim for a family show.
